The Holy Family with SS. Elizabeth and John the Baptist

Painted 1640-1642

The present painting, once attributed to Donato Creti, has only recently been rediscovered. It dates from the last phase of the artist's life and is stylistically comparable to The Infant Moses before Pharoah, acquired in 1977 by the National Gallery of Scotland, Edinburgh.
